



3D Event Designer Quick Start Guide

You can get started with 3D Event Designer in 5 easy steps.

The floor plan software works naitvely on all devices (Mac and PC computers, tablets and mobile phones) and you just need internet connection. For optimal performance, we recommend working in Google Chrome.

1. Create Your Space:

- Have Floor Plan: If you have an accurately scaled floor plan with at least one dimension start here: Upload and Scale a Floor Plan
- **Do Not Have Floor Plan:** If you do not have a floor plan, measure your space and start here: <u>Create a 3D Space with Only Dimensions</u>

Optional: To convert an uploaded 2D floor plan into a 3D space, and/or to make your floor plan look more realistic, use the following Guides:
